

Report on Workshops Seminars/Webinars


2019-20

During the academic year 2019-20, the institution faced significant challenges in organizing seminars and workshops due to the Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdowns. Despite these restrictions, it successfully hosted several virtual events.

1. On May 15, 2020, a webinar titled “Articles 14 & 21 of the Constitution & Law Evidence” was conducted, attracting 60 participants. For this Webinar were two resource Persons for this webinar, one was Civil Judge Senior Division of the District Court, Gondia and another Civil Judge Junior Div. of Akola District Court. This webinar was organized by the IQAC and Department of Law.
2. Following this, on May 23, 2020, another webinar focused on the “Impact of Covid-19 on Indian Politics and Economy” was held, with 70 attendees. Spoke person for this Webinar was Dr. Shubhangi Rathi HOD Smt. P.K. Kotecha Mahila Mahavidyalya, Bhusawal. This webinar was organized by the IQAC and Dept of Political Science.
3. Additionally, from December 9 to December 11, 2020, the institution organized a three-day National Conference on RTI and Human Rights. More than 320 Participants were joined the Conference. For First Day Invited Speakers spoke on the Role of RTI in Welfare State and 80 participants were benefited.

On a second day talk was on Human Right with two themes i.e. Human Rights of Women and Human Rights and Role of Suman Rights for these session 180 participants joined. On third day there were discourse on the topic of Human Rights of Farmers & Agrarian Laws in India and the position of Human Rights in India and 80 participants participated.

Throughout these challenging times, the institution remained committed to its academic mission, adhering to the guidelines set by the Parent University and state government. This proactive approach allowed the institution to continue fostering intellectual engagement and community discourse, demonstrating resilience in the face of adversity.

2020-2021

1. On March 24, 2021, the institution hosted a **Webinar on Intellectual Property Rights and the Patent Process** in collaboration with the Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Intellectual Property Management (RGNIIIPM) in Nagpur. This event attracted 92 participants, including students and faculty from various states.

Resource Person Mrs. Pooja Maulikar, Examiner of Patent and Designs, RGNIIIM, deliberated on Intellectual Property Rights and Patent Process from an expert's point of view. She elaborated how ideas with commercial value are intellectual Property and they should be saved from the danger of duplication. She highlighted the importance of IPR in the modern context where intellectual theft has taken new dimensions with more sophisticated gadgets invented. She also explained process of Patent registration through RGNIIIM, Nagpur office.

The last session of the webinar was kept for interaction with the partisans and questions-answer. Participants asked various questions regarding IPR. One of the participant asked about the role of advocates in protecting intellectual property rights. Mrs. Maulikar responded saying that advocates can very well protect the rights under the provisions of IPC. The webinar was attended by the 92 students and faculties from various states.

2. Additionally, an **Entrepreneurship Webinar** focused on the challenges and opportunities for youth was conducted on 19 January 2021, drawing 130 attendees from different colleges. The webinar was organized in association with Surya Foundation, Nagpur. To this Webinar 12 colleges were associated and many students and faculties participated.

Report on Workshops Seminars/Webinars

2022-2023

1. The institute has been proactive in organizing a diverse range of workshops, seminars, and webinars to enhance the educational experience of its students and faculty. Notably, an **Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Webinar** was held on January 31, 2023, which attracted **60 participants**, including students and faculty members. This session focused on the significance of intellectual property in the modern economy. Resource Person for the IPR was Dr. Pankaj Kumar, DPIIT IPR Chair at National Law University and Judicial Academy, Assam. This webinar was organized by Department of Law and IQAC of NMD College and directed by department of Industry and Internal Trade, Government of India (NIPAM 2.0) National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission.
2. On January 13, 2023, an **Entrepreneurship Workshop** brought together **100 students**, equipping them with essential skills and knowledge to navigate the entrepreneurial landscape. Earlier, on August 11, 2022, NMD College, Gondia Board of Students' Development organized workshop on my entrepreneurial journey. Mr. Pratik Lalwani founder of Devine Delight, Gondia was resource person for this workshop.
3. A **RUSA Faculty Development Workshop** was attended by **30 faculty members**, emphasizing professional growth and development. On this occasion teaching and non-teaching members of NMD and DB Science College were present. Resource person of the workshop focused on the professional skill development among the teaching and non-teaching members of the college. Resource person had created groups and given tasks to the teaching and non-teaching members then taken discussion on it. All the members have actively participated.
4. The institute also prioritized social awareness by hosting a workshop on the **Role of Society towards Disabled Persons** on December 20, 2022, attended by **20 participants**. Resource person for this workshop express his view on the rights of person with Disabilities Act, 2016, In India protects the rights of people with disabilities is a prime concern. He further said government ensured that the person with disabilities must enjoy the right to equality, life with dignity and respect for his or her integrity equally with others.

5. Following this, a significant **Workshop on Important Needs of Cyber Security** was conducted on December 21, 2022, which engaged **200 students**, addressing pressing issues in the digital age. Dr. Choubey, Vice Chancellor Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati was a resource person. He threw light on the important needs of cyber law understanding among the masses and young generation and to aware the consequences accrued the misusages internet and social media.
6. Additionally, a **Self-Employment Workshop** on January 11, 2023, attracted **80 attendees**, focusing on self-sustaining career paths. Resource person spoke that the self-employment is earning income without being employed and paid by someone else. Being self-employed gives people flexibility but comes with certain tax implications.
7. On January 12, 2023, a **Jio Company Placement & Training Workshop** saw participation from **120 students**, preparing them for employment opportunities. Resource person opined that the Jio Institute achieved a remarkable 100 percent placement for youth and they must also participate and engaged themselves to prosper their future.
8. Other notable events included a **Workshop on Consumer Rights** on December 26, 2022, **attended by 50 students**. Resource person for this workshop were Mr. Neeraj Meshram, Manager SBI and Mr. Neeraj Gupta, Area Manager of SBI. They said that everyone must know consumer's rights especially their banking rights. As our team taking initiatives to aware consumers how to use NET Banking, Banking Apps etc. carefully to avoid frauds.
9. A **Legal Awareness Workshop** on January 13, 2023, with 110 participants. Resources Persons for this workshop was Judges of Gondia District Court. They threw light on the Legal Awareness or Legal literacy is the process of educating people about their rights and responsibilities under the laws. It can help people to recognize their rights under the Constitution of India,
10. **Aptitude Preparation & Placement Readiness Workshop** held on **17 February 2023**, on the auspicious Birthday of the Patron of the GES, Gondia Hon'ble Shri. Praful


Patel, Member of Parliament. 300 participants attended the workshop. The resource person Mr. Ashish Diwan guided the audience about the necessity to learn aptitude skills to face the challenges of the current scenario. He presented his views on aptitude tricks with questions and answers to the participants.

11. On April 3, 2023, a **Seminar on Mutual Funds Investment Awareness** gathered **60 students**. To empower the investor, the resource person opined that the investment in Mutual Funds is today's need. He further said mutual fund grows in long terms to secure the future of the individuals.
12. While a **Fire Safety Workshop** on April 18, 2023, engaged **120 participants**. Officers of the fire safety department demonstrated with various ways how to extinguish fire in emergency. They taught number of measures to become safe during fire emergency and presented live demonstration to extinguish fire to the students.
13. The **Nasha Mukti Workshop** on April 26, 2023, attracted **80 students**, promoting awareness against substance abuse. Dr. Vijay Bahekar was a resource person of the workshop. He said that the entire world is facing the menace of the drug addiction which has devastating impact on the addict, individual, family and a large section of the society. So there is need to aware the society with counseling and treatment for drug addicted person. There are number of Nasha Mukti Centers running in India to help and secure the life of addicted persons.
14. Finally, a **Workshop on Competitive Exams Guidance** was held on May 3, 2023, with **100 participants**. Shri. Dinesh Tathe, Unique Academy Pune, was a resource person of the workshop. He stated the importance of correct approach and strategy is the key to qualify and competitive examination that a candidate aspires to crack.



15. A Soft Skill Development Workshop on April 16, 2023, attended by **80 students**.

2023-2024

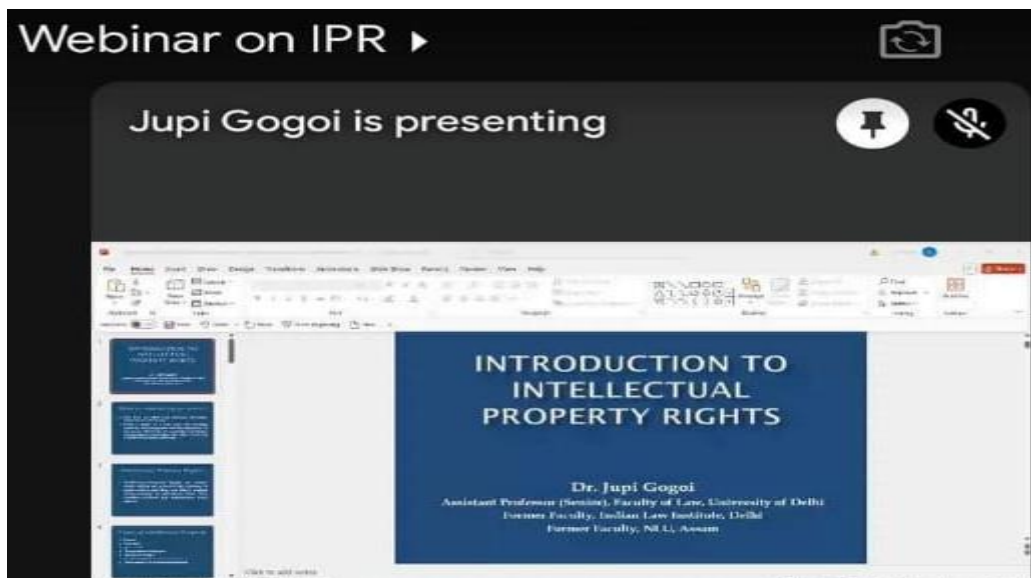
During the 2023-24 academic session, the institute actively organized a variety of workshops and seminars aimed at enhancing the educational experience and fostering awareness among students.

1. Under the direction and instructions received by the Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade, Government of India (NIPAM 2.0) National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission, Government of India, accordingly, the Department of Law, N.M.D. College Gondia organized Webinar on topic '**Intellectual Property Rights**' at Google Meet on virtual platform on 13th May, 2024. The IPR workshop was **attended by 70 participants**. The Workshop began with Recitation of Sanskrit Shloka and welcome of Chairperson of the Webinar & Principal of the College, Guest & Keynote Speaker of the webinar, IQAC Coordinator, Head, Dept., of Law, All HOD's of other department of the College, Teachers. Also welcome all the students who actively participated in this webinar to understand the importance of IPR.

Keynote Speaker and Chief Guest Dr. Jupi Gogoi Senior Assistant Professor in Law Centre 2, Faculty of Law University of Delhi in her key note address with the help of Power point Presentation unfolded the various areas of Intellectual Property Rights, as patent, copyrights, trademark Geographical indication, Industrial designs semi-conductors. While discussing on the patent rights she said that, 'Patent is always on the principles of first come first serve'. For registration of valid patent it has to qualify three test viz; novel, inventive steps, industrial application, that means these three things must be present then & then only he/she will get eligible for patent filing, she said. By quoting landmark judgement of Honorable SC in Dhanpath Seth v. Nilkamal Plastics. She said about the product patent and process patent, and what is the basic difference between them by quoting the ratio of Lalubhai Chakubhai Jarivala v. Shamaldas Sankalchand Shah (Almond Whitening Process case). She said that process patent is not on the product itself but on the process through which product is made only. Patent once granted is valid for 20 years, she said.

Apart from patent rights She highlighted the importance of copyrights as 'copyright is a right of paternity right' The author of the copyrighted book enjoys till his life span after his death his legal heir enjoy it up to 60 years and then it will be in public domain, but still the name of the author will be remaining integrity. She in her lecture explained what moral and economic rights related to copy rights are. She also

explained about the importance of trade mark laws as, it is a distinctive symbols that help the consumer to distinguish between similar goods or services, by giving small examples of brand name of iPhone, MI, kurkure, etc . She also explain about the important area of IPR i.e. Industrial design. She said when companies are competing at equal price and functionality DESIGN is the only differential that matters. Almost 70 % cost of the product is on the design we purchased. She also spoke on the lay out design of semiconductor circuit by giving examples of different company's phones differ regarding their function speed and utilities. In her lecture she also covered the importance of GI and GI related product their quality, test and usefulness. She quoted the examples of Assam tea, Nagpur Oranges, Ratnagiri Hapus Mango etc. If this product registered under GI Law, than this product of other place cannot sell in the name of that GI, GI helps consumers in identifying the genuine product, help GI producers to fetch a premium price for their product, she said in her presentation. In this way she has elaborately cover every aspect of IPR in clear language for students and teachers of other background. During question-answer session she satisfied the students doubts related to IPR.




2. One significant event was the **Seminar on Environmental Protection** held on June 5, 2023, which saw **participation from 60 students**. This seminar focused on the importance of safeguarding our environment and included discussions on sustainable practices and conservation efforts.

3. On January 12, 2024, the institute hosted a **Seminar on Legal Awareness**, attended by **50 students**. This event aimed to educate participants about their legal rights and responsibilities, fostering a better understanding of the legal system.
6. Following this, a **Workshop on Employment Opportunities and CET Preparation** took place on January 29, 2024, attracting **45 eager participants**. This workshop was designed to provide students with insights into various career paths and effective preparation strategies for competitive exams.
7. Additionally, on October 13, 2023, a **Workshop on Disaster Management** was conducted, drawing an impressive audience of **150 students**. This workshop aimed to equip students with essential skills and knowledge to respond effectively in emergency situations, highlighting the importance of Disaster Management.
